**Call to Order**

Sue Reynolds, President, called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM.

**Approval of March Minutes**

Membership was given time to read the March minutes and *upon motion made by Theresa Hayman and seconded by Melissa Schweitzer, the meeting minutes from March 2015 were approved. The motion carried unanimously.*

**Treasurer Report (Vicki White)**

- Spring concessions have been slow; hopefully improved weather will help. We bought three new grills. The Student Activities Office recommends purchasing covers for each and to not move them inside/outside constantly.
- A check arrived from B-Thrifty (\$134).
- Update on PayPal – it will run a spreadsheet. There is a fee to transfer more than \$500 at a time. PayPal was somewhat confusing for the more established/less tech-savvy group. The donations on PayPal were significantly down (not able to figure out how, etc.). The overall number of orders was about the same as last year. There were quite a few individuals who did not order this year that had last year.
